ELIGIBILITY

Open to all artists 18 years and older. from New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Delaware.

RULES OF ENTRY

Artists may submit collages, paintings, drawings, mixed media, photography sculptures. All work will be juried. Work previously hung in a juried art show at Smithville Mansion will not be accepted.

Work must be framed, wired and ready to hang. No clip frames or center hangers or adhesive hooks. Mats and glass must be clean and frames in good condition or they will not be accepted for exhibit.

Limit 3 pieces. Work selected must remain on display until the end of the exhibit.

FEE

A \$12.00 non-refundable entry fee per artist. Make checks payable to: Treasurer, Burlington County. The Office of Cultural Affairs and Tourism requests a 20% donation on the sale of exhibited works.
