ART ALONG THE RANCOCAS

Flora, Fauna, Bridges, Dams, Towns and Industry

May 9 - May 27, 2009

The Rancocas is a river of many names: to the Indians, the Ancocas; to the colonists, the Northampton River; to us, the Rancocas. The history of many Burlington County towns is intertwined with the Rancocas and its 3 branches: the Main stem: flowing from Rancocas State Park to the Delaware River; the North branch: traversing 31 miles from Brendan Byrne State Forest to Rancocas State Park; and the South branch, which includes both the south east and south western spurs of the waterway. 14 municipalities out of the 40 in Burlington County are touched directly by the waters of the Rancocas.

Artists are invited to exercise their creativity by choosing a variety of subjects from nature to history, from commerce to recreation, and more to memorialize the multi-faceted Rancocas and places associated with it. Along the Rancocas there are bridges, dams and mills, marinas and homes, and in some spots, ruins of structures from days gone by. There are at least a dozen historic towns built on the banks of the Rancocas. The history and culture of Burlington County cannot be defined without the inclusion of the Rancocas. ELIGIBILITY

Open to all artists 18 years and older from New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Delaware.

RULES OF ENTRY

Artists may submit collages, paintings, drawings, mixed media, photography sculptures. All work will be juried. Work previously hung in a juried art show at Smithville Mansion will not be accepted.

Work must be framed, wired and ready to hang. **No clip frames or center hangers or adhesive hooks.** Mats and glass must be clean and frames in good condition or they will not be accepted for exhibit.

Limit 3 pieces. Work selected must remain on display until the end of the exhibit.

FEE

A \$20.00 non-refundable entry fee per artist. Make checks payable to: **Treasurer, Burlington County.** The Office of Cultural Affairs and Tourism requests a 20% donation on the sale of exhibited works.
